Protecting your personal information

To stop personally addressed marketing material, or 'junk mail' being sent to you, you should contact the Mailing Preference Service either by phoning their registration number 0207 291 3310 or visiting their website where you can register online.

To stop uninvited telesales calls you should contact the Telephone Preference Service on 0345 070 0707 or visit their website where you can register online.

To stop uninvited telemarketing faxes you should contact the Fax Preference Service on 0345 070 0702 or visit their website where you can register online.

If you wish to obtain a copy of your credit file (i.e. a copy of your financial standing) you should write to the four main credit reference agencies. These are:
